Minutes of a meeting of Sandown Town Council Environment Committee held on Monday 04 September 2017 at 6.00pm at Business Hub College Close, Sandown

MEMBERS PRESENT: Cllr. Lawson (Chair) Cllr. Andre, Cllr. Grandchamp, Cllr. Humby and Cllr. Young

The member of the public asked questions about parking in the town, and on being asked by the Chair to respond, Cllr. Andre said that she would be having a ward walk with the Island Roads Steward for the area on the following Friday. She would raise the concerns with him. It was also mentioned that vehicles were being parked in for instance, Cross St., where parking for residents was at a premium, when they were not owned by anybody in the street. Although taxed and insured a green van had been there for some months without moving.

021/17 To agree and sign the minutes of the meeting held on 14 August 2017
The minutes of the meeting held on 14 August 2017 were approved and signed.

022/17 To discuss and make recommendations to Full Council re:-
Public Toilets – Lease, Eastern Gardens.
The Clerk made Councillors aware that at Eastern Gardens there was
a) A storage building attached to the back wall of the building, and
b) a ramp attached (seasonally) to the side wall.
These belonged to the person who leases the ground for the store and the beach huts from the Isle of Wight Council.

The leases for St. John's, Eastern Gardens and Yaverland had now been received and in accordance with minute 1522/17 of the July meeting of the Full Council, these will be signed and in due course become the full responsibility of this Council. Cllr. Andre was charged with the task of looking into the use of Danfo for temporary facilities and refurbishment of the permanent toilets.

It was also agreed that Cllr. Humby would contact Wayne Peake and make arrangements to meet up and speak to him about the possibility of the Pier toilets being used by the general public, which it was acknowledged was probably happening already.

Revetment - cycling

It was decided that consultation was needed with tourist groups, cyclist groups and private users, but prior to that the Clerk to liaise with Lake & Shanklin to see if they had any issues reported to them.

Ski Jets

As it was now the end of the season, this problem would be revisited.

Los Altos

Although the event had been enjoyed by many, there was now a problem with clearing up which was ongoing at today's date. The situation was being monitored.

Allotments
